**O projektu:**

Europska unija (EU) kroz fondove i programe pruža potporu za razne vrste projekata i aktivnosti. Instrument pretpristupne pomoći (IPA) jedan je od programa namijenjenih državama sa statusom potencijalnog kandidata i sa statusom kandidata za članstvo u EU u razdoblju od 2007. do 2013. godine.

Sa hrvatske strane u projekt su uključeni Hrvatski hidrografski institut (HHI) kao vodeći partner cijelog projekta i Sveučilište u Dubrovniku (Pomorski odjel).

Sa crnogorske strane sudjeluje Hidrometeorološki zavod Crne Gore (HMZCG) kao vodeći crnogorski partner i Nacionalna turistička organizacija Crne Gore.

Projekt je započeo u siječnju 2011. Predviđeno vrijeme trajanja je 23 mjeseca (do kraja 2012.). Ukupna vrijednost projekta za obje strane je 451.928,36 €.

Osnovni cilj projekta je unapređenje turističkog (posebno nautičkog) potencijala Dubrovačko-neretvanske županije i Crnogorskog primorja, kao jedinstvene turističke cjeline bogatog kulturnog i prirodnog naslijeđa, zajedničkom promidžbom, povećanjem kvalitete usluge te podizanjem razine sigurnosti u nautičkom turizmu.

U tu će se svrhu:

- izraditi i održavati web-stranica namijenjena nautičarima koji posjećuju predmetno područje
- izraditi nautičko-turistički vodič za jahte (jedrilice i motorne) i megajahte (preko 30 m duljine)
- osmisлити prekogranične nautičko-turističke plovidbene rute za jahte (jedrilice i motorne) i megajahte
- organizirati okrugli stolovi, prezentacije i promocije projekta
- organizirati institucionalno jačanje i podrška uspostavi Hidrografskog i oceanografskog odjela unutar Hidrometeorološkog zavoda Crne Gore itd.

Sastanak je održan dana 21.09.2012. u prostorijama općine Tivat s početkom u 10:00 sati.

Započeo je uvodnim riječima Luke Mitrovića, direktora HMZCG-a, te Zvonka Gržetića, ravnatelja HHI-a o projektu i aktivnostima projekta. Predstavnik HHI-a Vinka Jurić, project assistant je vodila sastanak.

**Aktivnost 1.3 – Booklet:** Knjižica sa preporučenim nautičko-turističko plovidbenim rutama za jahte (jedrilice i motorne jahte) i megajahte – tvz. “Booklet” je tiskan i predstavljen projektnim partnerima.

**Aktivnosti 1.5. i 1.6. – izrada Turističko - nautičkih vodiča:** Predstavnici NTOMNE-a su predstavili prvu radnu verziju Turističko - nautičkih vodiča za jedrilice, motorne brodove i megajahte, o kojoj će se partneri očitovati svojim primjedbama i sugestijama.

Tijekom sastanka se detaljno prošlo kroz sve aktivnosti projekta. Zaključeno je da se projekt odrađuje sukladno zadnjem važećem Planu aktivnosti. Razgovaralo se o stanju prijavljenog projekta na drugi natječaj Cross – Border Programme Croatia – Montenegro under IPA Component II, Allocations for 2009, 2010 and 2011 pod nazivom „Joint Actions for Sea Pollution Prevention – JASPPer” i o mogućnostima daljnje suradnje u EU projektima.

**Aktivnosti 3.3., 3.4. – trening, hidrografska izmjera i obilazak i/b Hidra:** Predstavnici HHI-a su izvijestili partnere o rezultatima aktivnosti 3.3. (3 dnevni trening) koja se održala od 03.09.-06.09.2012. godine. Partneri su također izvješteni o tijeku aktivnosti 3.4.- hidrografska izmjera – koja se odvija od 18.09.- 02.10.2012. godine. Nakon sastanka upriličen je posjet i/b Hidra koji se u sklopu aktivnosti 3.4. nalazi u CG – Tivat, marina Porto Montenegro. Tijekom hidrografskih mjerenja i/b „Hidra,, i zajednička HR/CG ekipa, pronašla je najveću dubinu do sada izmjerenu u Bokokotorskom zalivu, blizu Perasta. Dosada poznata najveća dubina je izmjerena 2009. i iznosila je 64 m, a nova najveća dubina izmjerena prije par dana je 68m.
